

EXECUTIVE ORDER no. 1

WHEREAS, expenditures for the operation of state government and state-supported services have been increasing at an alarming rate; and

WHEREAS, previous studies of administrative costs and executive management have not been fully utilized nor implemented; and

WHEREAS, it is vital to the economic health of the State of Wisconsin that all state-supported services be managed on an efficient and economical basis and that the people of this State be assured of wise expenditure of their tax dollars for these purposes; and


WHEREAS, many leaders of business and industry of this State have volunteered gratuitous assistance in an appraisal of the administration of these services of the State, devoted to sound management of the State's expenditures;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WARREN P. ANGLIS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby establish the Wisconsin Committee on Improved Expenditure Management and do appoint and constitute Robert Dineen, Edmund Fitzgerald, Del A. Forsberg, Wayne J. Hood, W. E. Lellett, and C. Kuhl, C. I. Nelson, Howard M. Packard, W. S. Pierson, Donald A. Snyder, J. M. Switzer and W. L. Watson as members of said Committee, hereby authorizing and empowering them to make such studies and investigations as they may consider necessary to ascertain the means and manner by which the services of the State of Wisconsin may be afforded to its citizens in the most efficient, expeditious and economical manner, and, to that end, further authorizing and empowering them to select and retain as their agents and assistants such executives and experts from business and industry as are skilled in the conduct of private enterprise, all to be without cost to the State of Wisconsin.

IN FURTHERANCE WHEREOF, I charge every officer and employee of this State to furnish to the Committee and its assistants complete information concerning their respective departments, divisions, bureaus, and boards and to give to the Committee and its agents every assistance in the performance of their duties; and

UPON THE COMPLETION OF ITS WORK, I request that said Committee shall render to me a full report of its findings and such recommendations as said Committee shall deem appropriate in the premises.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed, done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty sixth day of February, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty five.
