

EXECUTIVE ORDER No. 5


WHEREAS, the 300th Anniversary of Father Jacques Marquette's voyages on this continent will be celebrated nationally for a five year period beginning in 1968 and ending in 1973; and

WHEREAS, the history of the State of Wisconsin was shaped in part as a result of Father Marquette's voyages of discovery in the nation's heartland, including Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable and appropriate to establish a citizen organization to organize and coordinate Wisconsin's participation in the observance of this anniversary;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WARREN F. KNOWLES, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby establish the Governor's Marquette Tercentenary Committee and do appoint and constitute William D. Vogel, Committee Chairman; Henry E. Maier and Fred Petersen, Associate Chairmen; Dan Baisel; H.M. Benstead; W.E. Buchanan; Very Reverend Dennis M. Burke, O. Praem; Leo Crowley; Scott M. Mackin; Stanton Mead; Eugene Murphy; C.F. Nighbor; Eugene Palmbach; L.E. Phillips; Miss Gertrude Puelicher; Paul Pike Pullen; Guido Rahr; Very Reverend John P. Raynor, S.J.; J.M. Sweitzer; Mari Termeter; Mrs. Clarence Weber and Judge Clayton Van Pelt as members of said Committee, which will function as a General Committee of the Governor, to plan and coordinate Wisconsin's participation in the observance of the 300th anniversary of Father Marquette's work in America.
