WHEREAS, persons now serving on such committees remain members until they resign or until they are removed or replaced by action of the governor;

AND WOMEREAS, I would like current members to continue to serve until such time as I have had an opportunity to review the membership and purposes of each such committee;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, PATRICK J. LUCEY, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby recreate the following nonstatutory committees:
