EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 103

WHEREAS, a vacancy exists in the office of Municipal Judge for the City of Oak Creek in the County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin, as a result of the resignation of The Honorable Kenneth McCool, whose term of office would have expired on April 30, 1984;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEE SHERMAN DREYFUS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Wisconsin Statutes Section 8.50, do hereby order that a Special Election, to fill the existing vacancy be held;

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by the circulation of nomination papers, then the Special Election shall be held on April 5, 1983. The circulation of nominating papers for candidates may commence on December 17, 1982; the deadline for filing nomination papers for candidates shall be 5:00 p.m., January 4, 1983. The special primary shall be held on February 15, 1983.

AND, if nomination for such office is to be accomplished by a nominating caucus, then the nominating caucus shall be held in accordance with Wisconsin Statutes Section 8.05(1) on or before January 25, 1983, and the Special Election shall be held on April 5, 1983.


AND, the election shall be noticed, held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with the law.
