

WHEREAS, Wisconsin Sheriffs and the Wisconsin Department of Corrections must work together to maximize the efficiencies of community corrections; and

WHEREAS, through a cooperative effort, Wisconsin Sheriffs, the Department of Correction and the residents of Wisconsin can realize the benefits of more efficiency in conducting community corrections;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Section 14.019 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Create the Governor's Task Force on Jails and Community Corrections (hereinafter "Task Force") and shall consist of twelve (12) members appointed by the Governor to serve at the pleasure of the Governor; and
2. Provide that the Governor shall designate one (1) member of the Task Force as chair to serve in that capacity at the pleasure of the Governor; and
3. Provide that the Task Force shall have the following mission:
 - a. Study the current policies and procedures related to probation and parole holds; and
 - b. Seek means of efficiency in community corrections for Wisconsin Counties and the Wisconsin Department of Correction; and
 - c. Generate solutions and the necessary means of implementation;
4. Require the Task Force to draft a final report due to the Governor by January 10, 2003; and
5. Direct the Department of Administration to provide the Task Force with such sums of money as are necessary for travel and operating expenses in accordance with Section 20.505 (3) (a) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and
6. Provide that the Task Force shall dissolve when its final report is accepted by the Governor;

EXECUTIVE ORDER 38. Relating to a Special Session of the Legislature.

EXECUTIVE ORDER 39. Relating to the Creation of the Governor's Task Force on Small Business Regulatory Reform.

WHEREAS, small business is Wisconsin's largest employer and greatest generator of jobs; and

WHEREAS, Wisconsin's 100,000 small businesses are a key sector of Wisconsin's economy, providing more than 1.2 million jobs and \$21 billion in payroll income; and

WHEREAS, 96 percent of Wisconsin businesses of fewer than 100 employees; and

WHEREAS, regulations can be disproportionately burdensome to small businesses which have limited resources to meet the high costs of compliance in comparison to large businesses;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Section 14.019 of the Wisconsin Statutes, do hereby:

1. Create the Governor's Task Force on Small Business Regulatory Reform (hereinafter "Task Force") consisting of twelve (12) members appointed by the Governor to serve at the pleasure of the Governor; and
2. Provide that the Governor shall designate two (2) members of the Task Force as Co-chairs to serve at the pleasure of the Governor; and
3. Provide that the Task Force shall have the following mission:
 - a. Examine the existing statutory provisions, administrative rules and other state policies related to the regulatory process and recommend actions or legislative changes needed to ensure efficient and cost effective regulation; and
 - b. Assure smaller businesses achieve regulatory compliance without unnecessary expense or inconvenience; and
 - c. Review ways to reduce the negative impact of state rules and regulations on small businesses; and
4. Require state agencies to analyze the impact of the regulatory actions on small entities and determine if a rule will have a significant economic impact on a substantial level of small businesses; and
5. Direct the Department of Commerce to provide support to the Task Force; and
6. Direct the Department of Administration to provide the Task Force with such sums of money as are necessary for travel and operating expenses in accordance with Section 20.505 (3) (a) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and
7. Provide that the Task Force issue a report to the Governor within one year of the first meeting date; and
8. Provide that the Task Force shall dissolve when its final report is accepted by the Governor.

EXECUTIVE ORDER #1

WHEREAS, Section 14.019, Wisconsin Statutes, provides that under general powers of the Executive Office, the Governor may create and abolish statutory committees by Executive Order; and

WHEREAS, said Section provides that any non-statutory committee created under Section 14.019 shall expire on the fourth Monday of January of year in which a new gubernatorial term of office begins, unless the new Governor by Executive Order, provides for its continued existence; and

WHEREAS, persons now serving on such committees remain members until they resign or until they are removed or replaced by action of the Governor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby recreate the following non-statutory entities, effective fourth Monday of January, 1987:
