- 2. Provide that the Governor shall designate one (1) member of the Task Force as chair to serve in that capacity at the pleasure of the Governor; and
- 3. Provide that the Task Force shall have the following
- a. Study the current policies and procedures related to probation and parole holds; and
- b. Seek means of efficiency in community corrections for Wisconsin Counties and the Wisconsin Department of Correction; and
- c. Generate solutions and the necessary means of implementation:
- 4. Require the Task Force to draft a final report due to the Governor by January 10, 2003; and
- 5. Direct the Department of Administration to provide the Task Force with such sums of money as are necessary for travel and operating expenses in accordance with Section 20.505 (3) (a) of the Wisconsin Statutes; and
- 6. Provide that the Task Force shall dissolve when its final report is accepted by the Governor;


