

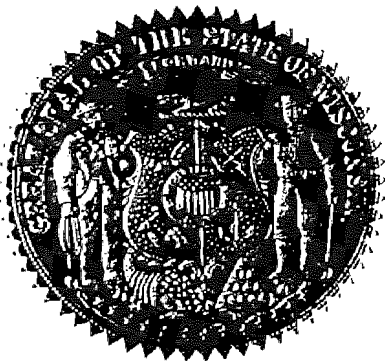

EXECUTIVE ORDER #39


Relating to amending Executive Orders #28 (dated 11/17/87) and #37 (dated 5/16/88) to expand a Special Session of the Legislature.

I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Article IV, section 11 and Article V, section 4 of the Constitution of Wisconsin do amend Executive Orders #28 (dated 11/17/87) and #37 (dated 5/16/88), which required the convening of a Special Session of the Legislature at the Capitol in Madison on November 18, 1987 at 9:00 am, by adding to its business consideration and action upon the following specific legislative business:


- (1) To enact legislation relating to the Wisconsin retirement system, fixed retirement investment trusts and transferring funds, limiting property tax levies, dispute settlement procedure in local government employment and granting rule-making authority.
