EXECUTIVE ORDER #62

Relating to a Special Election for the
Ninety-ninth State Assembly District

WHEREAS, State Representative Margaret Farrow was elected to the State Senate, representing the Thirty-third Senate District, on June 27, 1989; and

WHEREAS, State Representative Margaret Farrow has notified the Governor that she will resign as a State Representative from the Ninety-ninth Assembly District pursuant to Wis. Stats. s. 8.50 (4)(e);

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute section 8.50 (4)(e) order that a special election be held on September 12, 1989 to fill the vacancy in the Ninety-ninth Assembly District as described in Wis. Stats. s.4.99 for a term expiring the day preceding the first Monday in January, 1991, and that if a primary is necessary, it be held on August 15, 1989. Circulation of nomination papers for candidates may begin on the date of this order and nomination papers may be filed no later than 5:00 p.m., July 18, 1989. This section shall be held, conducted, canvassed and returned in accordance with law.
