Order to Limited Service of the Wisconsin National Guard

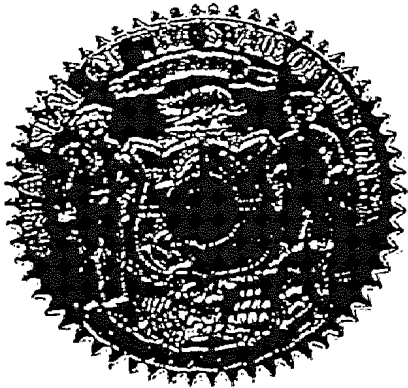
WHEREAS, tornados and heavy rains occurred in Central Wisconsin on June 8, 1993, causing flooding and damage; and


WHEREAS, several areas were in need of National Guard assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of this State, and specifically by Wisconsin Statute section 21.11, do hereby:

Direct the Wisconsin National Guard and the Division of Emergency Government to assist state and local government agencies in taking whatever actions within the state that are necessary to aid in the recovery of said flooding and tornados.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this the fifteenth day of June in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-three.
