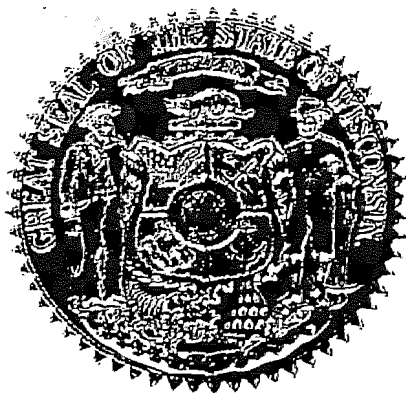
EXECUTIVE ORDER #254

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flags of the United States and the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for the Three United States Diplomats who Recently Died in Bosnia-Herzegovina


WHEREAS, on August 19, 1995 a tragic accident occurred near Sarajevo, Bosnia-Herzegovina; and

WHEREAS, this accident resulted in the death of three dedicated and able United States diplomats.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TOMMY G. THOMPSON, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all State buildings and grounds equipped with such flags beginning forthwith until sundown August 23, 1995.



IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this twenty-second day of August in the year one thousand nine hundred and ninety-five.
