
Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Assistant Fire Chief Dana Johnson of the Grantsburg Volunteer Fire Department

WHEREAS, on February 25, 2001, Assistant Fire Chief Dana Johnson of the Grantsburg Volunteer Fire Department died in the line of duty while courageously fighting a mutual aid fire in the town of Siren; and

WHEREAS, Assistant Fire Chief Johnson bravely and honorably served the people of Grantsburg and the people of the State of Wisconsin;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SCOTT McCALLUM, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by Federal and State law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags beginning at sunrise on March 2, 2001, and ending at sundown on that date.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the Capitol in the City of Madison this first day of March in the year two thousand and one.
