WHEREAS, on September 29, 2006, Principal John Klang tragically lost his life during a shooting at Weston High School; and

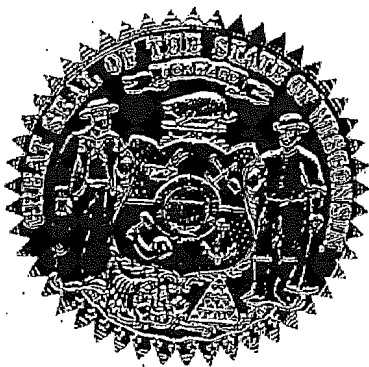

WHEREAS, the service and sacrifice of Principal John Klang is a tribute to the many dedicated educators all over Wisconsin who devote themselves to our kids; and


WHEREAS, the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Principal John Klang; and

WHEREAS, Principal John Klang will be laid to rest on Wednesday, October 4, 2006;


