



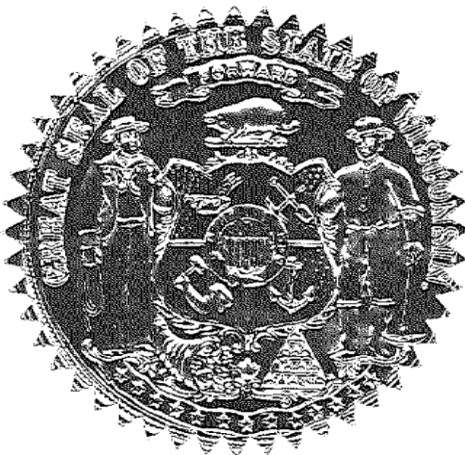


Suspending Executive Order #108

WHEREAS, on July 5, 2005, Governor Jim Doyle issued Executive Order #108, reaffirming executive branch practice relating to the employment of apprentices on state construction projects.


