**EXECUTIVE ORDER #161**

**Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for South Shore Ambulance Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Dennis Swenson**

**WHEREAS**, on Friday, May 1, 2015, Dennis Swenson, an Emergency Medical Technician, died in the line of duty while responding to a house fire; and

**WHEREAS**, Dennis Swenson was a volunteer EMT and a valued member of his community in the Bayfield County area, serving his community as an EMT for twenty-seven years; and

**WHEREAS**, Dennis Swenson's death has impacted the entire community, and the people of Wisconsin mourn the death of Dennis Swenson; and

**WHEREAS**, a memorial service will be held for Dennis Swenson in Herbster, Wisconsin, on Saturday, May 9, 2015;


**NOW THEREFORE, I, SCOTT WALKER**, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by federal and state law, do hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags, beginning at sunrise on **May 9, 2015**, and ending at sunset on that date.
