EXECUTIVE ORDER #96

Relating to a Proclamation that the Flag of the United States and the Flag of the State of Wisconsin Be Flown at Half-Staff as a Mark of Respect for Captain Kelly Lynn Raether of the Town of Ixonia Fire & EMS

WHEREAS, on November 26, 2020, Captain Kelly Lynn Raether, of Ixonia, passed away after contracting COVID-19 in the line of duty, as she responded to the emergency medical needs of a COVID-19 patient;

WHEREAS, Captain Kelly Lynn Raether served the people of the State of Wisconsin as an emergency medicine technician for over 15 years;

WHEREAS, in addition to serving her community, Captain Kelly Lynn Raether was a professor of nursing, teaching the next generation of health care providers;

WHEREAS, Captain Kelly Lynn Raether was a loving and dedicated daughter, beloved by her extended family and friends, and a valued member of the Ixonia community;

WHEREAS, a funeral will be held for Captain Kelly Lynn Raether on Saturday, December 5, 2020, in the Town of Ixonia; and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Wisconsin and the Town of Ixonia are forever grateful for the service, selflessness, and sacrifice of Captain Kelly Lynn Raether of the Town of Ixonia Fire & EMS.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TONY EVERS, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the State, hereby order that the flag of the United States and the flag of the State of Wisconsin shall be flown at half-staff at all buildings, grounds, and military installations of the State of Wisconsin equipped with such flags **beginning immediately and ending at sunset on Saturday, December 5, 2020.**
