Under **2013 Assembly Bill 670**, the owner of a snowmobile that is at least 30 years old at the time that the owner applies for registration may register the snowmobile with the Department of Natural Resources as an antique snowmobile. Such a registered snowmobile is exempt from reregistration while under the same ownership.

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 allows registration of snowmobiles as antique snowmobiles, if they are at least 35 years old, for an initial fee of \$20 and a renewal fee of \$5 every two years. The bill allows someone who has already applied for registration of a snowmobile that is at least 35 years old before this bill becomes law to renew that registration for \$5.

Bill History

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 was offered by Representatives Williams and Loudenbeck. On February 27, 2014, the Assembly Committee on Natural Resources and Sporting Heritage recommended adoption of the amendment and passage of Assembly Bill 670, as amended, by votes of Ayes, 13; Noes, 0.
