



1995 ASSEMBLY BILL 819

January 25, 1996 - Introduced by Representatives MUSSER, OLSEN, BLACK, ALBERS, NASS, AINSWORTH, F. LASEE, GRONEMUS, BOYLE, VRAKAS, GUNDERSON and SERATTI, cosponsored by Senators BUETTNER and MOEN. Referred to Committee on Veterans and Military Affairs.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 15.07 (1) (cm) and 15.315 (1) of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 changing the composition and terms of the state emergency response board.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill adds a representative of the department of industry, labor and job development (currently named the department of industry, labor and human relations) to the state emergency response board and provides that the members of that board serve for 4-year terms instead of at the pleasure of the governor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 15.07 (1) (cm) of the statutes, as affected by 1995 Wisconsin Act 27,
4 section 95m, is amended to read:
5 15.07 (1) (cm) The term of one member of the ethics board shall expire on each
6 May 1. The terms of 3 members of the development finance board appointed under
7 s. 15.155 (1) (a) 6. shall expire on May 1 of every even-numbered year and the terms
8 of the other 3 members appointed under s. 15.155 (1) (a) 6. shall expire on May 1 of
9 every odd-numbered year. The terms of the 3 members of the land and water
10 conservation board appointed under s. 15.135 (4) (b) 2. shall expire on January 1.
11 The term of the member of the land and water conservation board appointed under

1 s. 15.135 (4) (b) 2m. shall expire on May 1 of an even-numbered year. The terms of
2 members of the real estate board shall expire on July 1. The terms of the appraiser
3 members of the real estate appraisers board and the terms of the auctioneer and
4 auction company representative members of the auctioneer board shall expire on
5 May 1 in an even-numbered year. The terms of the 4 members of the educational
6 technology board appointed under s. 15.105 (26) (a) 1., 3., 6. and 9. shall expire on
7 May 1 in an even-numbered year. The terms of the members of the public intervenor
8 board shall expire as provided in s. 15.345 (4) (b). The terms of 3 members of the
9 gaming board appointed under s. 15.64 shall expire on July 1 of an even-numbered
10 year and the terms of the other 2 members shall expire on July 1 of an odd-numbered
11 year. The terms of 8 of the members of the state emergency response board shall
12 expire on May 1 of an even-numbered year.

13 **SECTION 2.** 15.315 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

14 15.315 (1) STATE EMERGENCY RESPONSE BOARD. There is created a state
15 emergency response board, which is attached to the department of military affairs
16 under s. 15.03. The state emergency response board shall consist of one
17 representative of the department of military affairs, division of emergency
18 government, one representative of the subunit of the department of health and
19 family services that administers health-related programs, one representative of the
20 department of industry, labor and job development, one representative of the
21 department of transportation, one representative of the department of natural
22 resources, one representative of the department of agriculture, trade and consumer
23 protection, one representative each from fire fighting, law enforcement and public
24 or community health services, 2 representatives of industry, one representative of
25 small business, as defined in s. 15.227 (3), 2. representatives who are elected officials

1 or employes of county ~~and~~ or municipal government, one representative of a farm or
2 agricultural organization, one representative of a labor organization and one
3 representative of an environmental organization. The members of the board shall
4 serve ~~at the pleasure of the governor~~ 4-year terms.

5 **SECTION 3. Nonstatutory provisions.**

6 (1) Notwithstanding section 15.315 (1) of the statutes, as affected by this act,
7 the members appointed to the state emergency response board under that subsection
8 shall serve for the following initial terms:

9 (a) One of the members representing industry, the member representing fire
10 fighting, the member representing a labor organization, the member representing
11 small businesses and the member representing the department of natural resources
12 shall serve for terms expiring on May 1, 1997.

13 (b) The member representing a farm or agricultural organization, the member
14 representing the department of agriculture, trade and consumer protection, the
15 member representing the department of military affairs and the member
16 representing an environmental organization shall serve for terms expiring on May
17 1, 1998.

18 (c) The other member representing industry, the member representing public
19 or community health services, the member representing law enforcement and one of
20 the members representing elected officials or employes of county or municipal
21 government shall serve for terms expiring on May 1, 1999.

22 (d) The other member representing elected officials or employes of county or
23 municipal government, the member representing the department of health and
24 family services, the member representing the department of transportation and the

1 member representing the department of industry, labor and job development shall
2 serve for terms expiring on May 1, 2000.

3 **SECTION 4. Effective date.**

4 (1) This act takes effect on July 1, 1996.
