March 19, 1996 - Introduced by Senators RUDE, SCHULTZ, JAUCH and HUELSMAN, cosponsored by Representative OURADA. Referred to Committee on Health, Human Services and Aging.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** the awarding of grants to area health education centers and
2 making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the board of regents of the University of Wisconsin System and the Medical College of Wisconsin, Inc., administer an area health education center (AHEC) program that supports community-based primary care training programs. This bill provides grants of \$7,500 to each of the following area health education centers: the Milwaukee AHEC, Inc.; the Eastern Wisconsin AHEC, Inc.; the Southwest Wisconsin AHEC, Inc.; and the Northern Wisconsin AHEC, Inc.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; other.**

4 (1) AREA HEALTH EDUCATION CENTERS.

5 (a) Within 30 days after the effective date of this paragraph, from the
6 appropriation under section 20.250 (1) (c) of the statutes, the Medical College of
7 Wisconsin, Inc., shall award grants of \$3,750 to each of the following area health
8 education centers:

9 1. The Milwaukee Area Health Education Center, Inc.
