



1995 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 34

June 22, 1995 - Introduced by Senators DECKER, BRESKE, JAUCH and CHVALA, cosponsored by Representatives WIRCH, VANDER LOOP and TURNER. Referred to Committee on Senate Organization.

1 **Relating to:** the service of Joe Gruber to working men and women.

2 Whereas, Joe Gruber has been a strong labor leader for many years; and

3 Whereas, Joe Gruber was first elected president of Allied Industrial Workers
4 of America, Local 849, in 1962, while working at Regal Ware; and

5 Whereas, Joe was appointed Region 9 representative of the Allied Industrial
6 Workers of America, for whom he handled bargaining contracts, grievances and
7 arbitration disputes; and

8 Whereas, Joe Gruber was appointed by Governor Schreiber to the Wisconsin
9 Council on Developmental Disabilities and served on the National Association of
10 Developmental Disabilities Council's Employee Protection Committee from 1977 to
11 1989; and

12 Whereas, Joe Gruber was elected executive vice president of the Wisconsin
13 AFL-CIO in 1974, a position that he held until his retirement in 1994; now,
14 therefore, be it

15 **Resolved by the senate, the Assembly concurring, That** the members of the
16 legislature of the state of Wisconsin congratulate Joe Gruber on his years of service,

1 commend him on his distinguished career and wish him the best of everything upon
2 his retirement; and, be it further

3 ***Resolved, That*** the senate chief clerk shall provide a copy of this joint
4 resolution to Joe Gruber.
