



1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 115

1 **AN ACT to amend** 134.77 (4); and **to create** 125.12 (2) (ag) 7., 125.12 (4) (ag) 9.
2 and 134.77 (3m) of the statutes; **relating to:** the permitted size of malt liquor
3 containers and providing a penalty.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill prohibits the sale and offering for sale in this state of containers of malt liquor that contain more than a quart of that beverage. A person who violates that prohibition is liable for a forfeiture of not more than \$500 for a first offense, for a forfeiture of not more than \$1,000 for a 2nd offense and is subject to having the person's license to sell alcohol beverages revoked or suspended for a 3rd offense.
