



## 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 24

January 28, 1997 - Introduced by Representatives REYNOLDS, LORGE, OURADA, HASENOHRL, HUBER, BAUMGART, SERATTI, GOETSCH, AINSWORTH, OLSEN, GROTHMAN, LINTON, KAUFERT, BOYLE, SPRINGER, GRONEMUS and GUNDERSON, cosponsored by Senators DECKER, WELCH and BRESKE. Referred to Joint survey committee on Tax Exemptions.

1     **AN ACT to create** 70.11 (32m) of the statutes; **relating to:** creating a property  
2             tax exemption for snowmobile trail grooming equipment owned by nonprofit  
3             snowmobile clubs and used on state trails.

### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

This bill creates a property tax exemption for snowmobile trail grooming equipment that is used on state trails and that is owned by a nonprofit snowmobile club.

5             70.11 (32m) SNOWMOBILE TRAIL GROOMERS. Snowmobile trail grooming  
6             equipment that is used on state trails and that is owned by a nonprofit snowmobile  
7             club.
