



1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 36

March 11, 1997 – Introduced by Representatives HUEBSCH, MUSSER and GRONEMUS, cosponsored by Senators RUDE and MOEN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of Stephen Fredrick.

2 Whereas, Stephen E. Fredrick was born on December 15, 1945, in
3 Farmersburg, Iowa, and died in rural Mindoro on February 18, 1997; and

4 Whereas, Stephen Fredrick was a highly respected educator in the Coulee
5 region and a great sportsman; and

6 Whereas, Mr. Fredrick had a long and prestigious career in the field of
7 education, serving as an English teacher, the Melrose–Mindoro High School
8 principal and a district administrator; and

9 Whereas, Mr. Fredrick was an effective and tireless advocate for education and
10 for providing a safe and effective learning environment for his students; and

11 Whereas, Mr. Fredrick served his country with pride and distinction in Vietnam
12 in the 101st Airborne Division as a combat platoon sergeant, earning a Bronze Star,
13 2 Air Medals and the Combat Infantryman’s Badge; and

14 Whereas, Mr. Fredrick will be greatly missed by his family, friends, school
15 district and community; and

1 Whereas, Stephen Fredrick will be long remembered as a loving husband and
2 father and is survived by his wife, Lois, and their 2 daughters, Jennifer and Jessica;
3 now, therefore, be it

4 ***Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That*** the members of the
5 Wisconsin legislature salute Stephen Fredrick's many years of dedication to his
6 family, his country and his community, express their sorrow at his death and extend
7 condolences to his family and friends; and, be it further

8 ***Resolved, That*** the assembly chief clerk shall provide copies of this joint
9 resolution to Mr. Fredrick's wife and daughters.
