



1997 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 61

June 10, 1997 - Introduced by Representative CARPENTER, cosponsored by Senator BURKE.

1 **Relating to:** the life and public service of David Mogilka.

2 Whereas, David Mogilka was born on June 30, 1915, in Milwaukee, and died
3 on May 7, 1997, in Milwaukee; and

4 Whereas, he graduated from Bay View High School in Milwaukee and earned
5 a law degree from Marquette University in 1941; and

6 Whereas, immediately after earning his law degree he entered the U.S. armed
7 forces and served during World War II on the Galapagos Islands and in the Panama
8 Canal Zone; and

9 Whereas, after his return from military service he worked for the Veterans
10 Administration, the U.S. Bureau of the Census, the Internal Revenue Service and
11 the office of the Milwaukee City Attorney; and

12 Whereas, Mr. Mogilka was elected to the assembly in 1956 and was reelected
13 in 1958; and

14 Whereas, during his tenure in the legislature his abilities were recognized by
15 an appointment to the joint committee on finance; and

16 Whereas, after he left the assembly he returned to full-time employment at the
17 office of the Milwaukee City Attorney; and
