



2001 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 17

February 19, 2001 – Introduced by Representatives CARPENTER, TURNER and J. LEHMAN. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **To create** Assembly rule 98 of the statutes; **relating to:** reporting of campaign
2 contributions before the executive budget bill is passed.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Assembly Rule 98: This rule is created to require the reporting of campaign contributions before the executive budget bill is passed by both houses within 5 day after the contribution is received.

3 **Resolved by the assembly, That:**

4 **SECTION 1.** Assembly rule 98 is created to read:

5 **ASSEMBLY RULE 98. Campaign contributions.** (1) In this rule, “contribution,”
6 “legislative campaign committee,” and “personal campaign committee” have the
7 meanings given for the terms in section 11.01 of the statutes.

8 (2) A member, member’s personal campaign committee, or legislative
9 campaign committee that receives a contribution, after January 1 of the
10 odd-numbered year and before the executive budget bill introduced under section
11 16.47 (1) of the statutes is passed by both houses, that must be reported pursuant to

1 section 11.06 or 11.20 of the statutes shall report the contribution to the elections
2 board within 5 days after receiving the contribution.
