2005 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 57

September 26, 2005 - Introduced by Representative RHOADES, cosponsored by
Senator HARSDORF. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** proclaiming that October 5, in perpetuity, be recognized and celebrated
2 as Robin L. Ahrens Day.

3 Whereas, Robin L. Ahrens is a native daughter of the state of Wisconsin; and

4 Whereas, Robin L. Ahrens was a 1970 graduate of Hudson High School; and

5 Whereas, Robin L. Ahrens was a 1974 graduate of Utah State University with
6 a bachelor of fine arts degree in education and also received a media specialist degree
7 from James Madison University in Virginia in 1983; and

8 Whereas, Robin L. Ahrens went on to dedicate herself to public service after
9 graduation by becoming a school teacher and eventually going into law enforcement
10 as a Special Agent for the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and

11 Whereas, Robin L. Ahrens entered service as a Special Agent for the Federal
12 Bureau of Investigation on October 14, 1984, and was later assigned to the Phoenix
