



2011 ASSEMBLY BILL 662

March 6, 2012 - Introduced by Representative ENDSLEY, cosponsored by Senator LEIBHAM. Referred to Committee on Transportation.

1 **AN ACT** *to create* 347.447 of the statutes; **relating to:** safety mirrors on school
2 buses.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill expressly authorizes a school bus to be equipped with a supplemental mirror system, mounted on the passenger side of the school bus and designed to enhance operator visibility of children near the passenger side of the school bus, if the supplemental mirror system does not make inoperative or diminish the performance of any other mirror or safety device required on the school bus.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 347.447 of the statutes is created to read:
4 **347.447 Additional safety mirrors on school buses.** A school bus that is
5 painted as provided in s. 347.44 may be equipped with a supplemental mirror
6 system, mounted on the passenger side of the school bus and designed to enhance
7 operator visibility of children near the passenger side of the school bus, if the
