February 7, 2013 – Introduced by Representative Kahl, cosponsored by Senator Miller. Referred to Committee on Rules.

8	Whereas, Michael Harried was an avid curler and served on the Board of
9	Directors of the Madison Curling Club, based in McFarland; and
10	Whereas, Michael Harried was dedicated and loyal to the McFarland
11	community his entire life and was the person others went to when something needed
12	to be done in McFarland; and
13	Whereas, Michael Harried was known for being a true gentleman in every
14	sense of the word, above reproach, fair, ethical, and unselfish. He respected
15	others—whether he agreed with them or not; and
