



## 2013 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 91

February 7, 2014 - Introduced by Representatives KOLSTE, BARNES, RINGHAND, JORGENSEN, RIPP, MILROY, KERKMAN, SINICKI, OHNSTAD, MURTHA, BERCEAU, HINTZ, HULSEY, BIES and PRIDEMORE, cosponsored by Senators T. CULLEN, VINEHOUT, MILLER, WIRCH, COWLES, KEDZIE and HARRIS. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1     **Relating to:** U.S.A. Olympic long track speed skater Tucker Fredricks.

2             Whereas, Tucker Fredricks, a native of Janesville, Wisconsin, has secured a  
3     position on the United States Olympic long track speed-skating team for a third  
4     consecutive Olympic Games; and

5             Whereas, Tucker Fredricks, born in Janesville in 1984, will seek to become the  
6     third straight American to win the Olympic 500-meter speed-skating event when  
7     he competes in the games at Sochi, Russia; and

8             Whereas, Tucker Fredricks, the son of Dan and Shawn Fredricks of Janesville,  
9     finished twenty-fourth at the 2006 Olympic Games in Turin, Italy, and twelfth in the  
10    Games in 2010 in Vancouver, Canada; and

11            Whereas, Tucker Fredricks is a two-time national champion who won the  
12    overall World Cup title in the 500 meters in 2007 and again in 2010, took bronze in  
13    his event in the 2007 World Single Distance Championships, and has earned  
14    thirty-one World Cup medals in the 500-meter event, including twelve gold, six  
15    silver, and thirteen bronze since 2002; and
