2015 ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION 115

February 16, 2016 - Introduced by Representative BALLWEG, cosponsored by Senator DARLING. Referred to Committee on Rules.

1 **Relating to:** congratulating First Lady Tonette Walker and the Fostering Futures
2 Steering Committee.

3 Whereas, Fostering Futures strives to provide focus on improving the lives of
4 children, especially those in foster care, by sharing the concept of trauma-informed
5 care; and

6 Whereas, educating government officials on the science of early-brain
7 development and the impact of Adverse Childhood Experiences has been a priority
8 of Fostering Futures; and

9 Whereas, significant progress in this area can be made by promoting a
10 comprehensive approach that aligns the work of all three branches of government:
11 executive, legislative, and judicial; and

12 Whereas, Fostering Futures is promoting opportunities and offering
13 recommendations to translate the science of trauma-informed care into practice for
14 children and families in Wisconsin; and
