



2015 SENATE BILL 396

November 20, 2015 – Introduced by Senators L. TAYLOR, HARRIS DODD and SHILLING, cosponsored by Representatives BERCEAU, BROSTOFF, SPREITZER, C. TAYLOR and YOUNG. Referred to Committee on Universities and Technical Colleges.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 36.11 (3) (d) (intro.); and *to create* 20.285 (1) (e), 20.292 (1)
2 (es), 36.11 (3) (e) and 38.14 (15) of the statutes; **relating to:** waiver of
3 University of Wisconsin System and technical college application fees and
4 making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires University of Wisconsin System (UWS) institutions and technical colleges to waive application fees for state residents who are high school juniors or seniors and who apply during the second full week of October. The bill appropriates general purpose revenues to reimburse UWS institutions and technical colleges for the fees that are waived.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 20.285 (1) (e) of the statutes is created to read:
6 20.285 (1) (e) *Application fee waivers.* A sum sufficient to reimburse
7 institutions for application fee waivers required under s. 36.11 (3) (e).
