



## 2015 SENATE BILL 439

December 7, 2015 - Introduced by Senators LASSA, SHILLING, CARPENTER, L. TAYLOR, VINEHOUT, WIRCH, C. LARSON, HARRIS DODD, RINGHAND, BEWLEY, HANSEN and MILLER, cosponsored by Representatives VANDERMEER, BILLINGS, SARGENT, MASON, KOLSTE, KRUG, KAHL, SKOWRONSKI, GOYKE, BROSTOFF, C. 1     **AN ACT** *to create* 14.28 of the statutes; **relating to:** the creation of a Women's

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill creates a Women's Suffrage Centennial Commission in the office of the governor. Under the bill, the commission must make appropriate plans and preparations for the commemoration of the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3           **SECTION 1.** 14.28 of the statutes is created to read:  
4           **14.28 Women's Suffrage Centennial Commission.** (1) The Wisconsin  
5           Women's Suffrage Centennial Commission shall make appropriate plans and  
6           preparations for the commemoration of the 100th anniversary of women's suffrage.
