



2017 ASSEMBLY BILL 696

November 29, 2017 - Introduced by Representatives CONSIDINE, C. TAYLOR, GENRICH, HESSELBEIN, POPE, FIELDS, GOYKE, ZAMARRIPA, BERCEAU, SUBECK, ANDERSON, BILLINGS, SARGENT, SHANKLAND, KOLSTE and SINICKI, cosponsored by Senators ERPENBACH, WIRCH, JOHNSON, HANSEN and VINEHOUT. Referred to Committee on Corrections.

1 **AN ACT to create** 302.072 of the statutes; **relating to:** correctional officer
2 required to be present when staff interacts with a segregated prisoner.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill requires that a correctional officer be present during each interaction between a prisoner who is in segregated status and a staff member who is not a correctional officer.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 302.072 of the statutes is created to read:

4 **302.072 Officer presence required.** If a prisoner who is in segregated status
5 interacts with a staff member who is not a correctional officer, the warden or
6 superintendent of the prison shall ensure that a correctional officer is present during
7 the entire interaction.
