



2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 23

February 12, 2019 - Introduced by Representatives BALLWEG, GUNDRUM, KULP, NOVAK, RAMTHUN, RODRIGUEZ, SKOWRONSKI, THIESFELDT, WICHGERS, ZIMMERMAN and TUSLER, cosponsored by Senators FEYEN, DARLING and TESTIN. Referred to Committee on Workforce Development.

1 **AN ACT relating to:** career and technical education incentive grants and making
2 an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, Department of Workforce Development may award an incentive grant to a school district in which students successfully completed certain industry-recognized certification programs approved by DWD. This bill increases the appropriation by \$3,500,000 in fiscal year 2019-20 and fiscal year 2020-21 to fund the incentive grants.

3 **SECTION 1. Fiscal changes.**

4 **SECTION 2. Effective date.**

5 (1) This act takes effect on the day after publication, or on the 2nd day after
6 publication of the 2019 biennial budget act, whichever is later.
