



2019 ASSEMBLY BILL 295

June 13, 2019 - Introduced by Representatives RIEMER, B. MEYERS, ZAMARRIPA, L. MYERS, C. TAYLOR, GOYKE, KOLSTE, HEBL, SHANKLAND, VINING, DOYLE, ANDERSON, BILLINGS, POPE, HESSELBEIN, SPREITZER, OHNSTAD, EMERSON and CONSIDINE, cosponsored by Senators RINGHAND, CARPENTER, SMITH and LARSON. Referred to Committee on Ways and Means.

1 **AN ACT** *to amend* 71.54 (1) (g) (intro.); and *to create* 71.54 (1) (h) of the statutes;
2 **relating to:** increasing the homestead tax credit maximum income.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the homestead income tax credit is not allowed to claimants whose household income exceeds \$24,680. Under this bill, that threshold is increased to \$30,000 for claims filed in 2020 and thereafter.
