1 **Relating to:** proclaiming April 2021 as Parkinson's Disease Awareness Month.

2 Whereas, Parkinson's disease is the fastest-growing neurological disorder in
3 the world; and

4 Whereas, the effects of Parkinson's disease touch the families, friends, and
5 communities of approximately 20,000 Wisconsinites who suffer from Parkinson's
6 disease; and

7 Whereas, research has not been able to identify an exact source of the disease
8 for many individuals suffering from the disease; and

9 Whereas, Parkinson's disease has no known cure, and treatments are limited
10 in their ability to address the medical needs of individuals with the disease; and

11 Whereas, volunteers, caregivers, medical practitioners, and researchers are
12 working to advance the treatment of medical conditions associated with Parkinson's
13 disease and to better understand how to prevent it; and

14 Whereas, additional education, awareness, and research on Parkinson's
15 disease will improve the lives of many Wisconsinites; now, therefore, be it
