2021 SENATE BILL 1074

March 9, 2022 - Introduced by Senators AGARD, BEWLEY, RINGHAND, ROYS and L. TAYLOR, cosponsored by Representatives SUBECK, HONG, BALDEH, BROSTOFF, CABRERA, CONLEY, DRAKE, EMERSON, HAYWOOD, HEBL, POPE, SHANKLAND, SINICKI, SNODGRASS, SPREITZER and HESSELBEIN. 1 **AN ACT to repeal** 104.001 of the statutes; **relating to:** local minimum wage
2 ordinances.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits a city, village, town, or county from enacting and administering an ordinance establishing a minimum wage. This bill eliminates that prohibition.
