AN ACT relating to Fines and Forfeitures.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SEC. 1. That all fines and forfeitures imposed as a punishment for any offence or for violation or neglect of any duty imposed by any statute, shall be appropriated and accrue to the use of the county where the offence is committed or the duty is violated. Fines and forfeitures accrue to the use of the county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to establish certain Territorial Roads.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SEC. 1. That Hamilton Stevens, J. P. Brower, and Elbert Dickason, be authorised to lay out and establish a territorial road commencing at Madison, the seat of government of this territory, and extending thence, by the nearest and most direct route to Frankfort, in the county of Dodge. Madison and Frankfort road

SEC. 2. That said commissioners be required to lay out and establish said road agreeably to the provisions of an act, entitled "An act to provide for the laying out and opening territorial roads," approved January 11, 1840. How to lay out

SEC. 3. The said commissioners shall proceed to lay out and establish said road, in the manner above prescribed, within three months from the passage of this act, and not thereafter. When.
