AN ACT to legalize the official acts of Thomas McKaig.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Acts of Thos. McKaig, legalised.

SEC. 1. That the official acts of Thomas McKaig, a foreigner, while acting as a justice of the peace for the county of Walworth, are hereby declared to be as valid and binding upon all persons and parties interested therein, as if the said Thomas McKaig had been, at the time of executing the duties of said office, a citizen of the United States, and of said territory, and as such, duly qualified to hold said appointment of justice of the peace: and the acts and proceedings of the said McKaig, as such justice, shall not be questioned in any court or place whatsoever, for the reason that said McKaig was an alien while holding and exercising the office of justice of the peace as aforesaid.

AN ACT to incorporate the Fox and Wisconsin Steam Boat Company.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Corporators of Fox and Wisconsin Steam Boat company

SEC. 1. That John P. Arndt, William Mitchell, Alexander I. Irwin, David Jones, Daniel Whitney, William H. Bruce, Charles A. Grignon, William Dickinson, Randall Wilcox, David Ward, and Hoel S. Wright, and such other persons as may associate with them, are hereby declared a body corporate, by the name and style of the "Fox and Wisconsin Steam Boat Company," for the purpose of building one or more steam boats to navigate the Fox or Wisconsin rivers, and to carry and
