ceiver of the Milwaukee and Rock River Canal, the amount which may have been paid for such redemption, with seven per cent. interest on such payment; and such payment when made shall defeat any title or claim to any such lands, which the Territory may have acquired by such redemption.

AN ACT to change the time for holding the annual meetings of the several boards of county supervisors.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin :

§ 1. That the annual meeting of the board of county Commission. supervisors, shall hereafter be held on the first Monday in hold meetings each year, following the day now prescribed by law, for holding the general elections in this Territory.

§ 2. The chairman of town supervisors in the several towns, whose duty it shall be to attend the annual meeting of the board of county supervisors, shall return the poil No charge for books of the general election of their respective towns, book. without charge for mileage.

§ 3. In case of the absence by sickness or other cause of the chairman of the board of supervisors, one of the board present shall return the poll books at the time turn poll book specified in section one, and shall be paid as is by law now provided.
