

**AN ACT** to authorize the town Brookfield, in the county of Milwaukee, to collect certain delinquent taxes for the year 1844.

*Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.*

**SECTION 1.** The supervisors of the town of Brookfield, in the county of Milwaukee, are hereby authorized to correct the assessment roll for the year 1844, in the same manner as is provided in the fifteenth section of an act to amend an act, entitled "An act to provide for the government of the several towns in this territory, and for the revision of county government," approved April 15th, 1843; and the same shall be as valid in law as if it had been done within the time prescribed by law.

**SEC. 2.** The assessment roll when so corrected, shall be placed in the hands of the collector of said town, who shall proceed to collect the same, and shall make his returns thereon on or before the first Monday of April next.

**SEC. 3.** This act shall [take effect and] be in force from and after [its passage.]\*

**AN ACT** to authorize the construction of a free bridge across Rock River.

*Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.*

**SECTION 1.** That William A. Goodrich, George W. Ogden, Adin Burdick, Edward Palmer and Freeborn Sweet and their associates, be and are hereby authorized to build and maintain a free bridge across Rock River, at some point on said river between Lake Koshkonong and the place used as a ferry by Ansel Goodrich, including said ferry: *Provided*, that nothing herein contained shall impair any right or privilege of the owner of the said ferry without his consent.

**SEC. 2.** The said bridge shall not be less than eighteen feet
