

Provided, that all damages on such cases and the costs of ascertaining the same shall be paid by the commissioners, or by the persons interested in the road.

APPROVED, February 22, 1845.

AN ACT to authorize the board of supervisors of Milwaukee county to collect certain delinquent taxes in the towns of Summit and Oconomewoc for the year A. D. 1842.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the board of supervisors of the county of Milwaukee, at their next annual meeting, are hereby authorised to add to the tax apportioned to the towns of Summitt and Oconomewoc, the delinquent tax apportioned to the town of Summit for the year A. D. 1842; and that the assessment of A. D. 1842, be taken as the basis of said apportionment.

SEC. 2. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "An act in relation to the qualification of voters for State Government and for the election of Delegates to form a State Constitution.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That an act entitled "An act in relation to the qualification of voters for state government, and for the election of delegates to form a state constitution," approved January 22, 1844, be so amended as to read as follows: That no person shall hereafter vote upon the subject of state government, or for delegates to form a state constitution, who shall not have resided six
