

one and twenty-two in township No. eleven north of range No. fifteen east, shall lay out into a town plat, forty acres of land, of which the said quarter section stake shall be the centre, reserving a square of four acres, whenever the county commissioners shall select as a site for public buildings, and convey the said square of four acres and every alternate lot in said plat, to the county of Dodge, by good and sufficient deeds in law fee simple, to be approved by the county commissioners, and cause the same, together with the plot of said town, to be recorded in the Register's office of the county; then the seat of justice of Dodge county shall be located upon the site so selected for public buildings: *Provided*, the said conveyances be so made and so accepted of, before the first day of July next: *Provided, further*, that no contract for the erection of county buildings shall be entered into until Martin Rich, or some person for him, shall first secure to the county commissioners, the sum of one thousand dollars, which shall be applied to the erection of said buildings, and to no other purpose whatever.

SEC. 2. The county commissioners shall certify to the Register of Deeds of the county, the location of the square of four acres for public building selected by them, and also their acceptance of the conveyances which shall be received by the said Register and recorded with said conveyances.

SEC. 3. The ninth section of "An act to organize the county of Dodge, and to provide for locating the seat of justice of the same," approved January 20th, 1844; and all acts and parts of acts contravening the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

AN ACT to divide the town of Aztalan and to establish the town of Lake Mills.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That all that part of the town of Aztalan, comprised in townships Nos. seven and eight, in range No. thirteen in the county of Jefferson, be and the same is hereby set off into a separate town, by the name of Lake Mills, which town shall be

entitled to all the rights and privileges which other towns, are by law entitled to. The first election in said town, shall be holden at the house of Morgan L. Bartlett, on the second Tuesday of April next.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
APPROVED, February 22, 1845.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Washington County to construct and maintain certain bridges across Milwaukee river.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That it shall, and may be lawful for the county commissioners of Washington county, to construct all necessary bridges across the Milwaukee river within said county, and to keep up and maintain such bridges as are now constructed across said river in said county as public bridges: *Provided*, however that no bridge built, or to be built, under the provisions of this act, shall be so construed [constructed] as to hinder the free navigation of said river, by any craft that may navigate the same, or any raft that shall not exceed twenty feet in width.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, and may be altered, amended or repealed by any future legislature.

APPROVED, February 8, 1845.

AN ACT to organize certain towns.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

SECTION 1. That the south half of township numbered twelve, and the north half of township numbered eleven in ranges number thirteen and fourteen east, shall hereafter be known by the name of Beaver Dam, and that said tract of country is hereby incorporated for the purpose of holding property for public uses, and for no other purpose.
