

**AN ACT** to amend an act entitled "an act concerning costs and fees.

*Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.*

**Clerk's fees.** SECTION 1. The clerk of the Supreme court of this Territory shall receive the following fees for services by him rendered, to wit:
