

AN ACT to divide the town of Milton and organize the town of Lima.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Boundaries.

SECTION 1. All that district of country comprised in township number four, north of range number fourteen east, of the fourth principal meridian, being now a part of the town of Milton, be and the same is hereby set off into a separate town, and shall be known and distinguished as the town of Lima, in the county of Rock, and the first town meeting shall be held at the school house in school district number nine, in the said town of Milton.

SEC. 2. The said town set off and organized by this act, shall be entitled to, and enjoy all the rights and privileges which are granted by law to the other towns in this Territory.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to incorporate the Wisconsin Phalanx.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That Warren Chase, Uriel Farmin, Lester Rounds, Jacob Beckwith, Laban Stillwell and William Dunham, and all others who shall become associated with them as members, shall be, and they are hereby declared to be a body corporate and politic, to be known and designated as the Wisconsin Phalanx; and as such corporation, are hereby declared capable of suing and being sued, answering and being answered unto, pleading and being impleaded, defending and being defended, in all courts and places, in all suits, actions, matters and causes whatever. And said corporation shall have a continued and perpetual succession, and have power to make a common seal and change the same at pleasure.
