AN ACT to authorize school district number one, in the the town of Cassville, county of Grant, to levy a tax for building or purchasing a school house.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

SECTION 1. That the inhabitants of school district number one, in the town of Cassville, county of Grant, who are qualified ^{Inhabitants} voters at any school meeting in said district, may vote a tax ^{may vote a tax.} to be levied on all the taxable property in said district, not to exceed the sum of four hundred dollars, for the purpose of building or purchasing a school house in said district: *Provided*, that two ^{Proviso.} thirds of the legal voters of the same, who may be present at any meeting duly called by the trustees for that purpose, shall vote in favor of the tax authorized by this act.

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the trustees of said district to give notice of any meeting to be called by them for the purpose of ^{Duty of trustees.} levying said tax, by posting written or printed notices of the same, in three of the most public places in said district, at least ten days previous to the time of holding said meeting.

SEC. 3. The said tax shall be levied, collected and returned ^{How levied and collected.} in the same manner that is now provided by law for the collection of taxes for building school houses. This act shall take effect and be in force from after its passage.
