trustees of said corporation to license groceries, victualling houses, taverns, and the sale of spirituous or strong liquors within said village, is hereby repealed: and the board of county commissioners of Iowa county, shall have the same power, authority and control over such licence as they would have had, if said act had not passed.

Trustees may appoint a president pro tem.

SEC. 3. In the absence of the president the trustees of said village may appoint a president pro tem., who shall have all the powers and rights, and perform all duties which by said act belong to, or devolve upon the president, any thing in the act to which this is amendatory, to the contrary, notwithstanding.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

APPROVED, February 21st, 1845.

AN ACT to authorize school district No. three, in the town of Johnstown, county of Rock, to levy a tax for the purpose of building a school house.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

Inhabitants may vote a tax.

Proviso.

SECTION 1. That the inhabitants of school district No. three, in the town of Johnstown, county of Rock, who are qualified voters, at any school meeting in said district, may vote a tax to be levied on the real estate in said district subject to taxation, not to exceed the sum of three hundred dollars, for the purpose of building a school house in said district: *Provided*, that two-thirds of the legal voters of the same, who may be present at any meeting duly called by the trustees for that purpose, shall vote in favor of the tax, authorized by this act.

Duty of trustees. SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the trustees of said district to give notice of any meeting to be called by them, for the purpose of levying said tax, by posting up written or printed notices of the same, in three of the most public places in said district, at least days previous to the time of holding said meeting. SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the trustees of said district, after the legal voters of the same shall have decided to levy the said tax, to assess within thirty days thereafter all property which by law is subject to taxation for the purpose of the erection of school houses, lying in said district subject to be taxed, and make out a tax list from their assessment roll, and deliver the same to the collector of said district, who shall collect and return the same in the manner prescribed by law, for the collection of taxes for

building school houses.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

APPROVED February 8th, 1845.

AN ACT to amend an act, entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Southport."

Be it be enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

SECTION 1. That upon the application of two thirds of the President and owners of real estate, on any street or part of street, it shall be trustees may lawful for the president and trustees to levy and collect a tax on levy a tax, dc. all the owners of real estate, or lots on such street, or part of street, according to the last assessed valuation of such real estate or lots, for the purpose of grading, paving or otherwise improving such street or part of street.

SEC. 2. That the president and trustees shall have power to May levy a levy a special tax for the purpose of purchasing one or more fire special tax. engines, and for the construction of reservoirs of water: also, for the furnishing of any other necessary apparatus for the extinguishment of fires: *Provided*, That any tax levied for the aforementioned purposes, shall not exceed one half per cent. on the assessed valuation of property in the village of Southport in any one year.
