

SEC. 3. It shall be the duty of the trustees of said district, after the legal voters of the same shall have decided to levy the said tax, to assess within thirty days thereafter all property which by law is subject to taxation for the purpose of the erection of school houses, lying in said district subject to be taxed, and make out a tax list from their assessment roll, and deliver the same to the collector of said district, who shall collect and return the same in the manner prescribed by law, for the collection of taxes for building school houses.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

AN ACT to amend an act, entitled "an act to incorporate the village of Southport."

Be it be enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin.

SECTION 1. That upon the application of two thirds of the owners of real estate, on any street or part of street, it shall be lawful for the president and trustees to levy and collect a tax on all the owners of real estate, or lots on such street, or part of street, according to the last assessed valuation of such real estate or lots, for the purpose of grading, paving or otherwise improving such street or part of street. President and trustees may levy a tax, &c.

SEC. 2. That the president and trustees shall have power to levy a special tax for the purpose of purchasing one or more fire engines, and for the construction of reservoirs of water: also, for the furnishing of any other necessary apparatus for the extinguishment of fires: *Provided*, That any tax levied for the aforementioned purposes, shall not exceed one half per cent. on the assessed valuation of property in the village of Southport in any one year. May levy a special tax.
