

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act concerning Masters in Chancery.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That Masters in Chancery be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to administer oaths in all cases when the same are required or allowed by law to be administered, and to take and certify the acknowledgments of deeds and other instruments in writing required to be acknowledged.

AN ACT to amend an act entitled "an act to provide for the government of the several towns in this Territory and for the revision of county government and for other purposes."

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. At every general or special town meeting for the election of any officer or officers the poll shall be kept open until the setting of the sun.

SEC. 2. That whenever any organized town in this Territory shall be divided, or any new town shall be organized, and by such division or new organization, there shall be a less number of justices of the peace in office in such new town than is authorized by law, all such justices as are then in office shall continue to hold their offices until the expiration of the term for which they may have been elected, and it shall be lawful for the qualified elec-
Justices to continue in office.
