

AN ACT for the relief of John J. Driggs.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the marriage contract heretofore existing between John J. Driggs and his wife Susan Driggs, be and the same is hereby dissolved, and the said John J. Driggs is hereby restored to all the rights and privileges of an unmarried man.

AN ACT to authorize certain persons to build a dam across Milwaukee river.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That the owners of the northwest quarter of section number thirty-six and the south west quarter of section twenty-five township No. eleven, in range No. twenty-one, in Washington county, their successors and assigns, be, and they are hereby authorized to erect and maintain a dam across Milwaukee river at such points on the aforesaid tracts of land, as they may deem most suitable, and to make use of the water for hydraulic purposes.

SEC. 2. Said dam shall not exceed six feet in height above high water mark of said river, and said proprietors shall construct and keep in good repair a sufficient chute not less than fifteen feet wide and so constructed as not to cause a fall of more than three feet to every twelve feet of smooth surface to admit of the passage of all rafts of timber down said stream.
