AN ACT

To provide for the payment of the claim of John Anderson against the territory.

Be it enacted by the Council and House of Representatives of the Territory of Wisconsin:

SECTION 1. That there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars for the payment of John Anderson for work done under his contract, in the construction of a dam on section number fifty-four of the Milwaukee and Rock river canal, and also such further sum as shall be necessary to pay the interest thereon, at the rate of seven per cent. per annum from the date of the respective estimates of the engineers of the territory who had the work in charge.

SEC. 2. The receiver of the canal funds is hereby authorized and directed to pay to John Anderson, or his legal representatives, out of any moneys in his hands, arising from the sale of canal lands, the sum by this act appropriated, upon the presentation and surrender to him, of the engineers' certifi-

cates or estimates of work done, under said Anderson's contract, as specified in the first section of this act.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

AN ACT

To divorce Caleb Crosswell from his wife E. Jane Crosswell.

SECTION 1. That the marriage contract between Caleb Crosswell and his wife E. Jane Crosswell, of Walworth county, is hereby dissolved, and the parties to the said contract, are, by virtue of this act, restored to all the rights and privileges of unmarried persons.
